Please think "Can I eat it now!")**

**TOILETARIES** *The life style of most of the clients is such that they need everything, every week. Surprisingly, soap is one thing we don't need, as there is limited access to water to use it, and the toilets they use supply it anyway! Again we have listed some suggestions. Small and many is better than big, as they will get lost quickly!:* Razors, Roll-on Deodorant, Shampoo, Shaving Cream, Loo Rolls, Household Candles
